

CALL FOR APPLICATIONS | PhD in Macroeconomics and Monetary Economics

AMSE is offering an ANR funded PhD position in Macroeconomics and Monetary Economics for 3 years, starting in the fall 2022. The PhD candidate is expected to participate to the ANR project (<u>Financial fragmentation and inequalities in the Eurozone</u>) and to co-author with the team members.

Advisor: Céline Gimet, Professor of Economics, AMSE.

RESEARCH ACTIVITIES

The selected candidate will be enrolled in the AMSE PhD Program. As full members of the research department, AMSE PhD students benefit from AMSE's dynamic academic environment. They attend various seminars series, present their work at the PhD brownbag seminar as well as at international conferences, participate to summer schools to acquire skills in their specific fields of specialization, and do visiting research stays in the best international universities. More information is available on the <u>AMSE website</u>. Students will be provided with a desk in of the AMSE buildings, in Marseille or Aix-en-Provence. Physical presence in AMSE facilities is required.

QUALIFICATIONS REQUIRED

The candidate should demonstrate a strong interest in regional monetary and financial integration topics with, in particular, the assessment of macroeconomic impacts of monetary policies. Knowledge of empirical methods in economics and finance and econometrics is expected. Knowledge of big data management and programming would be considered an asset. The applicant must have achieved a first class standing in a Master in economics equivalent to the ETE Research Master | AMSE.

MONTHLY SALARY

Around 1400 euros net of social contributions. The grant includes social security coverage. AMSE PhD candidates have the possibility to earn additional salary by applying to Aix-Marseille University Teaching Assistantships (Contrat Mission Enseignement).
