

AMSE – EcHoPPE PhD grant 2019-2022 Call for applications

Economics of Housing and
Public Policy Evaluation



The [Aix-Marseille School of Economics](http://www.amse-aixmarseille.fr) is inviting applications for a three-year PhD grants starting in fall 2019.

The PhD candidate will be enrolled in the [AMSE PhD program](#) and supervised by an AMSE faculty member. The monthly gross salary is 1 758 €. This amount includes social security coverage but is not net of income taxes. Teaching assistant positions might be available. AMSE PhD program yearly tuition fees amount about 400 €.

There are many public interventions on the housing market, and their impacts are far from being fully understood. The EcHoPPE project aims to help to have a better understanding of the consequences of these public interventions, both at the micro- and macro-level and considering both efficiency and equity aspects. As part of the EcHoPPE research project which gathers researchers from TSE (Thierry Magnac), LIEPP-Sciences Po (Etienne Wasmer) and AMSE (Alain Trannoy), the main focus of the PhD candidate will be on housing economics and inequality of social conditions.

Application procedure

Applicants must hold, prior to September 2019, the AMSE master in Economics, research track (Économie Théorique et Empirique) or a Master in economics from an institution that provides a level of training in economics at least as good as that of the AMSE. Applications are welcome from both French and non-French nationals. Knowledge of French is not necessary.
