



Aix-Marseille University AMSE PhD program 2021 admission procedure



AMSE master ETE track students

This procedure only applies to students enrolled in the AMSE master in Economics, research track (Empirical and Theoretical Economics). Other applicants must comply with the alternative dedicated procedure available from the AMSE PhD program webpage.

ADMISSION CRITERIA

- Completion of the AMSE master in Economics, research track (Empirical and Theoretical Economics).
- Supervision agreement by an AMSE faculty.
- Positive assessment of the full application package by the AMSE PhD committee.
- Full-time research funding for at least 3 years (applications to Aix-Marseille University doctoral grants are part of the admission process).

Deadline to submit full application package	June 8
Defenses of Master thesis and presentations of PhD projects	June 14-15
Invitation of selected applicants to apply for Aix-Marseille University PhD grants	June 18
Interview for Aix-Marseille University PhD grants	June 24
Deadline for submitting funding proof*	Around July 10
Latest release of admission decisions	Around July 10

**Applicants waiting for funding decisions to be made by third-party institutions need to submit a detailed update of their funding application's status by this date.*

APPLICATION PACKAGE

- A detailed cv and a cover letter.
- Detailed transcripts of bachelor- and master-level grades (grades of the ongoing academic year will be sent directly by the relevant program secretariat).
- A research project (max 10 pages).
- Supervision agreement by an AMSE faculty member.
- Master dissertation.

All documents must be sent as PDF files to the AMSE PhD program secretariat. The subject of the mail must be "YOUR_NAME – AMSE PhD Application". The first four items must be included in a single PDF file, following the order given above. The name of the file must be "YOUR_NAME – AMSE PhD Application.pdf". The name of the master dissertation file must be "YOUR_NAME – Master dissertation.pdf". Applicants who lobby for acceptance are subject to disqualification.
