- Positive assessment of the full application package by the AMSE PhD committee.

Application package

- Detailed CV and cover letter.
- Detailed transcripts of bachelor- and master-level grades (grades of the ongoing academic year will be sent directly by the relevant program secretariat).
- Research project (max 10 pages, including a 3-year agenda).
- Supervision agreement by an AMSE faculty member.
- Master dissertation.

All documents must be sent as PDF files to the AMSE PhD program secretariat.

The subject of the mail must be "YOUR_NAME - AMSE PhD Application". The first four items must be included in a single PDF file, following the order given above. The name of the file must be "YOUR_NAME - AMSE PhD Application.pdf". The name of the master dissertation file must be "YOUR_NAME - Master dissertation.pdf".

Applicants who lobby for acceptance are subject to disqualification.
